The meeting will follow the week of the ACCU conference (Apr 10th - 13th) and booking will be provided by the same online booking system that the ACCU conference will be using – we plan to provide a single registration for anyone attending both events.

Transportation

Heathrow airport is the recommended airport for most travelers (there is a small airport in Bristol, but only a few destinations are serviced.)

Transit from the airport to the hotel can be by:

Train Bristol Temple Meads station is about 1 mile from the hotel.

Heathrow Express to Paddington then First Great Western to Bristol Temple Meads

Cheaper: Tube into London, then the train from London Paddington as above

More direct: bus to Reading station, train to Bristol Temple Meads

Coach Direct coach service from Heathrow to the coach station on Marlborough Street, 0.8 miles from hotel (see www.nationalexpress.com)

Car Driving distance approx 100 miles (160 km).
There is car parking at the hotel, at 6 GBP/day.

Taxi Possible, but likely to be somewhat expensive (estimated 130 GBP one way)
